Rebates and Concessions Application Form

BHP Billiton Iron Ore provides a number of rebates to eligible customers in line with those offered by the State Government.

Energy Rebates

To be eligible for any of the following energy rebates you must hold at least one concession card.

Concession Card	Rebate Available
Western Australian Seniors Card	Cost of Living Assistance*
Commonwealth Seniors Health Care Card	Cost of Living Assistance*
Centrelink Health Care Card	Cost of Living Assistance* Account Establishment Fee Rebate
Centrelink Pensioner Concession Card	Cost of Living Assistance* Account Establishment Fee Rebate
Veterans Affairs Gold Card (War Widow).	Cost of Living Assistance* Account Establishment Fee Rebate
Veterans Affairs Pensioner Concession Card	Cost of Living Assistance* Account Establishment Fee Rebate
Any of the above cards (excluding Seniors / Seniors Health Care Card Holders) plus dependent children	As per card concessions plus Dependent Child Rebate**

*The Cost of Living Assistance is a State Government initiative that replaces the Supply Charge Rebate. This payment will increase the base yearly rebate to eligible recipients to \$200 per annum.

Airconditioning Rebate

BHP Billiton Iron Ore provides an air conditioning rebate to eligible seniors and concession card holders with dependant children. The rebate is equivalent to the cost of 200 kWh of electricity per applicable month to offset some of the electricity costs associated with operating an air conditioner.

The rebate applies:

- For 7 months between the months of October and April
- To accounts registered in the applicant's name; and
- For electricity supplied at residential tariff rates (A2).

To be eligible for the rebate you must hold:

- a valid Western Australian Seniors Card AND either a Centrelink Pensioners Concession Card OR a Commonwealth Seniors Health Card
- OR
- a Centrelink Health Care Card with dependant children OR a Pensioner Concession Card (issued by Centrelink or the Department of Veterans' Affairs) with dependant children OR a Veterans' Affairs Gold Card with dependant children.

- Customers supplied at the L2 (business) prices are not eligible to claim rebates under the State Government Energy Rebate Scheme.
- Rebates are applied from the date the approved application is received.
- Rebates are not retrospective and cannot be backdated.
